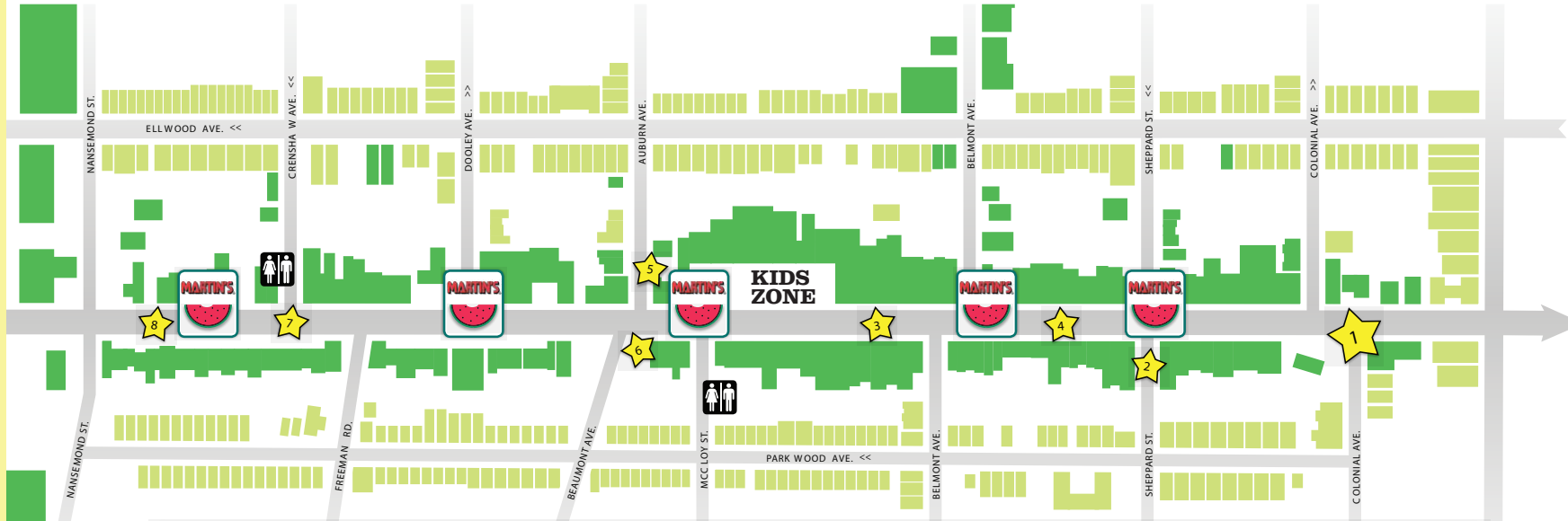


Tips for the Day
